



Polices & Procedures Park in well lit, secured areas

- Back against a wall or fence, if possible
- Lock and remove keys from cargo units, even when in a "secured lot"
- Lock your truck when parked
 - Jaguar (\$125,000) stolen off truck in Romulus yard keys left in the vehicle
 - 2 loaded trucks from 1 terminal (\$800,000)
- Ways to Control the key:
 - Fish Stringer
 - D hook
 - Small bag

CONTROL YOUR KEYS!

STEPS TO ENSURE KEY CONTROL AND DETER THEFT

Rollup all windows



Remove all keys/fobs from the vehicle



> Lock all doors



Close all doors, hood, trunk/hatch, fuel cover

Keep keys with you at all times. Do not leave keys unattended.



> Place keys in drop box for STI/AHD deliveries
